



## **CSDA Joins Coalition to Oppose Risky Energy Initiative**

At their May 2008 meeting, the CSDA Board of Directors approved the recommendation of the CSDA Legislative Committee to oppose the Solar & Clean Energy Initiative and join the Californians Against Another Risky Energy Proposition Coalition. The Solar & Clean Energy Initiative would impose significant new changes and unrealistic requirements on energy producers, including special districts involved in the delivery of this type of service to constituents. Additionally, experts are warning that the initiative would actually drive up prices for renewable power by setting targets that would force utilities to sign contracts regardless of how much they cost as well as unnecessarily shift oversight responsibilities among many other items.
